Daytime Closure on Bethany Road

Lebanon, Ohio – The Bethany Road Improvements Project is still underway. On Monday, December 12, 2011, the bridge between Meadowbrook Drive and Pinnacle Lane will be closed. A crane is being brought in to drive pilings on that day as part of the new bridge build. The closure will last from 7:30 a.m.; and 5:30 p.m., weather permitting. If rain or snow postpones the work, the closure will be for the following day.

The detour will be posted and will utilize Mason-Montgomery Road, US 42, Mason Road, and Butler-Warren Road.

They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
