Per Ohio EPA Rules and Regulations, The Warren County Water and Sewer Department has issued a boil advisory.

The boil advisory will be in effect as soon as water has been restored until further notice.

We hereby advise residents to take either of the following precautions:

1. During this advisory those customers affected may assure purity of their water by boiling vigorously for at least two (2) minutes.
2. Utilize bottled water for drinking and cooking purposes.

We are conducting water sampling in the affected area at this time. This boil advisory will remain in effect until the results of the water samples are obtained. When the water has been determined to be safe (coliform negative) we will advise you of this by issuing an All Clear Advisory.

This is purely a precautionary measure. The likelihood of contamination occurring is extremely minimal.
