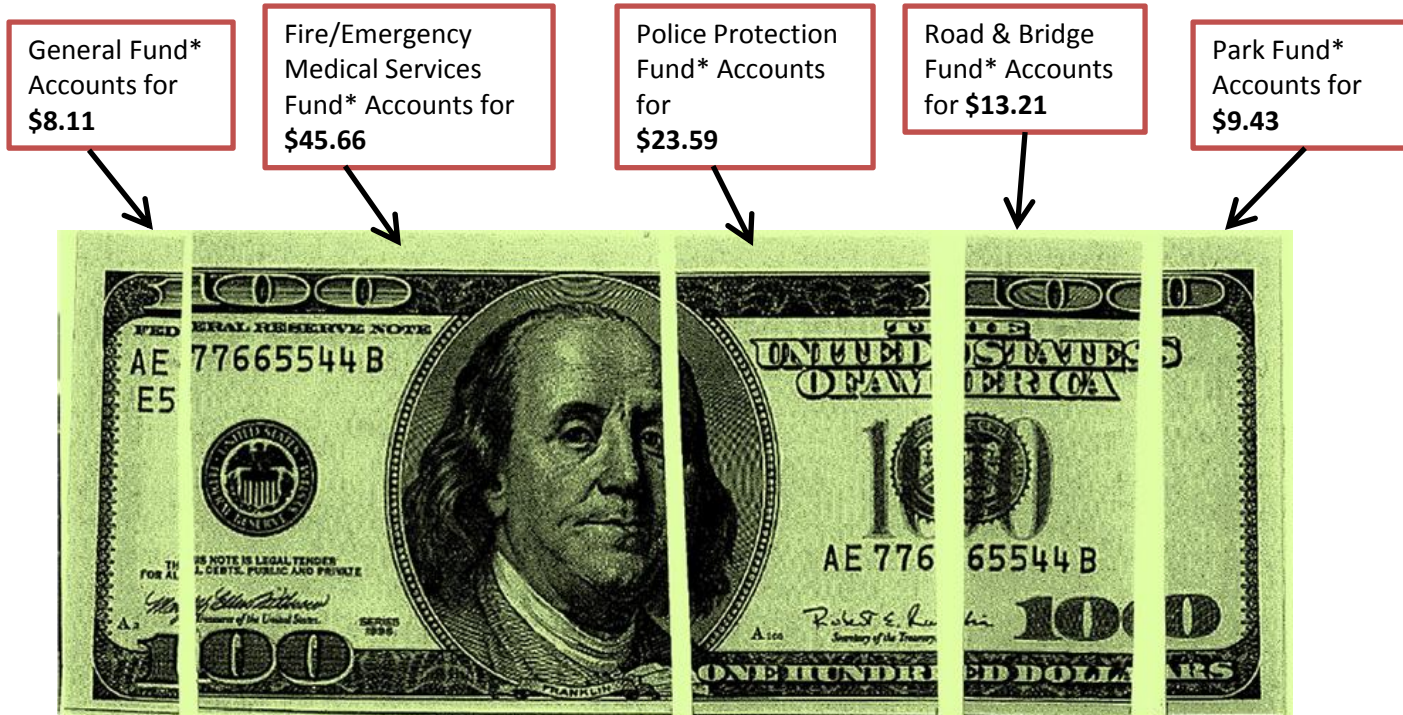

## **Where Your Deerfield Township's Tax Dollars are Spent. \***

### **\* FUND DESCRIPTIONS –**

- ❖ The General \$'S supports the overall operation of the Township. This includes Administrative personnel, Supplies, Equipment and Transfers to other funds to support those operations
- ❖ The Fire/EMS \$'s support 4 Fire/EMS stations and the 21 Full-Time and 55 Part-Time Associates. In 2008 the Department made 1,261 fire runs & 1,984 EMS runs. We maintain 5 fire trucks, 4 paramedic ambulances & 8 other support vehicles -24/7 coverage
- ❖ The Police Fund \$'s support 25 Sheriffs cruisers and other necessary police equipment. In 2008 the Department handled a total of 19,327 calls. The four highest call areas were 2,792 traffic stops, 1,489 burglar/intrusions, 1,385 EMS assists & 1,238 property damages
- ❖ The Road & Bridge Fund \$'s support the Supplies, Vehicles, Equipment and 8 Full-Time Road Associates that maintain 96 miles of road, hold cleanup days in April, provide brush pickup monthly, maintain all street signs and provide snow removal.
- ❖ The Park Fund dollars support the Supplies, Vehicles, Equipment and 4 Full-Time Park Associates. The Township boasts 400 acres of Park land that includes 5 main parks. Our Parks include all amenities and provides programs for all age groups through out the year.
