DRSWD has contracted with CDM Smith to update the SWMP along with the SWP3's for the Township facilities. The Parks Department and Road Department have been consolidated into a unified Service Department at one location. The former Parks facility has been decommissioned and remodeled and will be used as community meeting space.

DRSWD has entered into an agreement with the Warren County Commissioners to share in the cost of hiring Strand Associates to update and rewrite existing regulations. A product of this project will be erosion and sediment control, stormwater, and illicit discharge regulations written specifically for Deerfield Township and the authority granted to it by the O.R.C. as a Home Rule Township. It is anticipated that these will be adopted by the Township in the first half of 2021.
