RESOLUTION 2006- 57

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL AND DESTRUCTION
OF SIGNS PLACED IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF PUBLIC ROADS**

WHEREAS, the Zoning Resolution of Deerfield Township currently prohibits placement of signs in the right-of-way of public roads in Deerfield Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees has determined that the most effective means of enforcing the existing prohibition against the placement of signs in the public right-of-way is to authorize Township employees to remove and destroy such signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Trustees of Deerfield Township, Warren County, State of Ohio, that in addition to any other remedies provided in the Zoning Resolution of Deerfield Township, the Township may remove and destroy any signs placed or affixed within the right-of-way of any public road or highway within the Township unless the sign is located in the right-of-way pursuant to a permit issued by the Warren County Engineer or the Ohio Director of Transportation; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the requirement that the resolution be read at two separate meetings is waived and this resolution shall take effect in thirty (30) days.


