The Coronavirus crisis is affecting almost everyone's routines, transportation, and some "non-essential" services. This means that the usual support and contacts that many vulnerable elderly adults have with others may be diminished.

In response, local organizations (*Community Champions*) are partnering with the United Way of Warren County Volunteer Resource Center and Warren County Community Services in a "Supporting Seniors Through COVID" program.. This program asks members of the community to purchase from the list of specific items to create care packages that can be delivered to older adults throughout Warren County who continue to shelter in place during this time.

Community members are invited to help while maintaining social distancing by shopping for and donating items from the list.

By providing at least three items from the list you can make a huge difference to the quality of life for a local senior.

After purchasing, simply put sealed / unopened items in a tied shopping bag and deposit it in the bin to be distributed to those in need in our community.
